In accordance with the clause 2.3 of the exemption granted on 23 April 2013, we advise:

For the period 24 October 2014 – 23 April 2015 non-compliant buses were used on the following days:

<i>30 December 2014</i>	<i>Falls Festival</i>
<i>01 January 2015</i>	<i>Falls Festival</i>
<i>07 February 2015</i>	<i>Wooden Boat Festival</i>
<i>02 April 2015</i>	<i>Easter Thursday (school holiday)</i>

Non-compliant buses were used due to additional passengers travelling to events in Hobart and Launceston or high loadings in the case of the first day of school holidays.

One non-compliant bus was used on each occasion and a compliant bus was also used on the same service.
