

## Submission 101

### Part 1

Dear Human Rights Commission,

Thank you for taking interest in this problem.

I have a nightmare of a story, where I was sexually assaulted by the [REDACTED] CEO of an [REDACTED] Medical service.

Looking into how the police took my complaint, which is disgraceful, the the role of HR, Fair Work, insurance companies, policies and procedures, doctors and lawyers, [REDACTED] SafeWork, [REDACTED] etc.. the situation of sexual harassment in workplaces will remain the same because when it is reported, the victim is further traumatised by this disgraceful system.

The victim has to prove they are 15% damaged, dealing with psychiatrists who are obviously sweetened by insurance companies. The perpetrators are not subjected to gruelling psychological assessments and their mental health is never challenged.

The victim has to repeat and relive the nightmare over and over.

In my case, the perpetrator has a history of sexual assault complaints, [REDACTED] [REDACTED] yet he remains unaccountable. There is talk that this man has a history in 4 organisations. Where is the duty of care to the public that this has been ignored? He works in vulnerable communities and is in s position of power, which is a terrible combination.

4 years - my matter is still not over - and this in itself is traumatic.

If you are a resilient person, this goes against you. The system is not fair. It is a waste of resources and feeds lawyers and doctors. The insurance companies have a lot to answer for.
