Protecting our children is a critical task for human rights.

However, currently there's a problem with the current Working With Children Check system in Australia. The system is managed by each states separately, which makes it difficult for organisations involving multiple states as they have to waste duplicate resources dealing with multiple government agencies/web sites and could have potential issues when volunteers from different states were involved. It's 2018 and quite normal/reasonable for organisations dealing with children to cross the state border or involve people from different states. The current WWCC system should be revised and managed at federal level rather than each individual states, this will make the whole system more efficient, less loopholes/issues and less efforts for all organisations/companies involving children.
